1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the current **Racing Rules of sailing, including the U. S. Sailing Prescriptions** and as altered by these sailing instructions.
- 1.2 Racers will comply with all requirements of MCCA's rental policy except monetary.

2. Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is invitational and only open to teams designated to represent invited yacht clubs affiliated with the U.S. Naval Sailing Association.
- 2.2 Teams will be Two Persons each, Two Teams per club. Team skippers will be required to complete a SMYC race entry form.

3 Notice to Competitors

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the club bulletin board located at the Santa Margarita Yacht Club (SMYC) Clubhouse. Provisional information may be posted on club's web site at www.santamargaritayc.org.

4. Changes in Sailing Instructions

- 4.1 Any changes to these sailing instructions will be posted on the official regatta bulletin board no later than 1000 hours on the day of the regatta, with code flag "L" displayed.

5 Schedule of Races

- 5.1 Five races are scheduled for 5 November 2011. The Warning Signal for the first race is planned for 1225. A courtesy sound signal, (multiple horn blasts) may be provided. If so, it shall be approximately 30 seconds prior to the warning signal for each race.

6. Class Flag

- 6.1 Class flag is numeral "1" pennant.

7. Racing Area

- 7.1 Racing shall occur in the Del Mar Boat Basin and Entry Channel
- 7.2 Caution should be observed along the North and South edges of the entry channel for shallow water.

8. Courses and Marks

- 8.1 Courses are described on page 3 of these sailing instructions.
- 8.2 The race committee will signal the course using placards posted on the Port Side of the committee boat, course in Arabic and laps in Roman Numerals.
- 8.3 Marks will be ball shaped floats approximately 18" in diameter.

9 The Start and Finish

- 9.1 Races will be started in accordance with rule 26.
- 9.2 The starting line will be between an Orange Flag on the Committee Boat and a ball shaped float.
- 9.3 The finish line will be the same as the start line.
- 9.4 When more than one lap is ordered, To finish a lap, sail through the Start/finish line from the direction of the last mark and continue to sail the last lap (see course chart).

10 Recalls

- 10.1 General and individual recalls will be in according to rule 29.

11 Protests

- 11.1 Race/Protests committee will explain rule infringements not cleared by alternative penalty.
- 11.2 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

12 Alternative Penalty

- 12.1 The 720° turn's penalty is modified to one 360° turn that shall include one tack and one jibe in the same direction. This changes rule 44.2.

13 Scoring

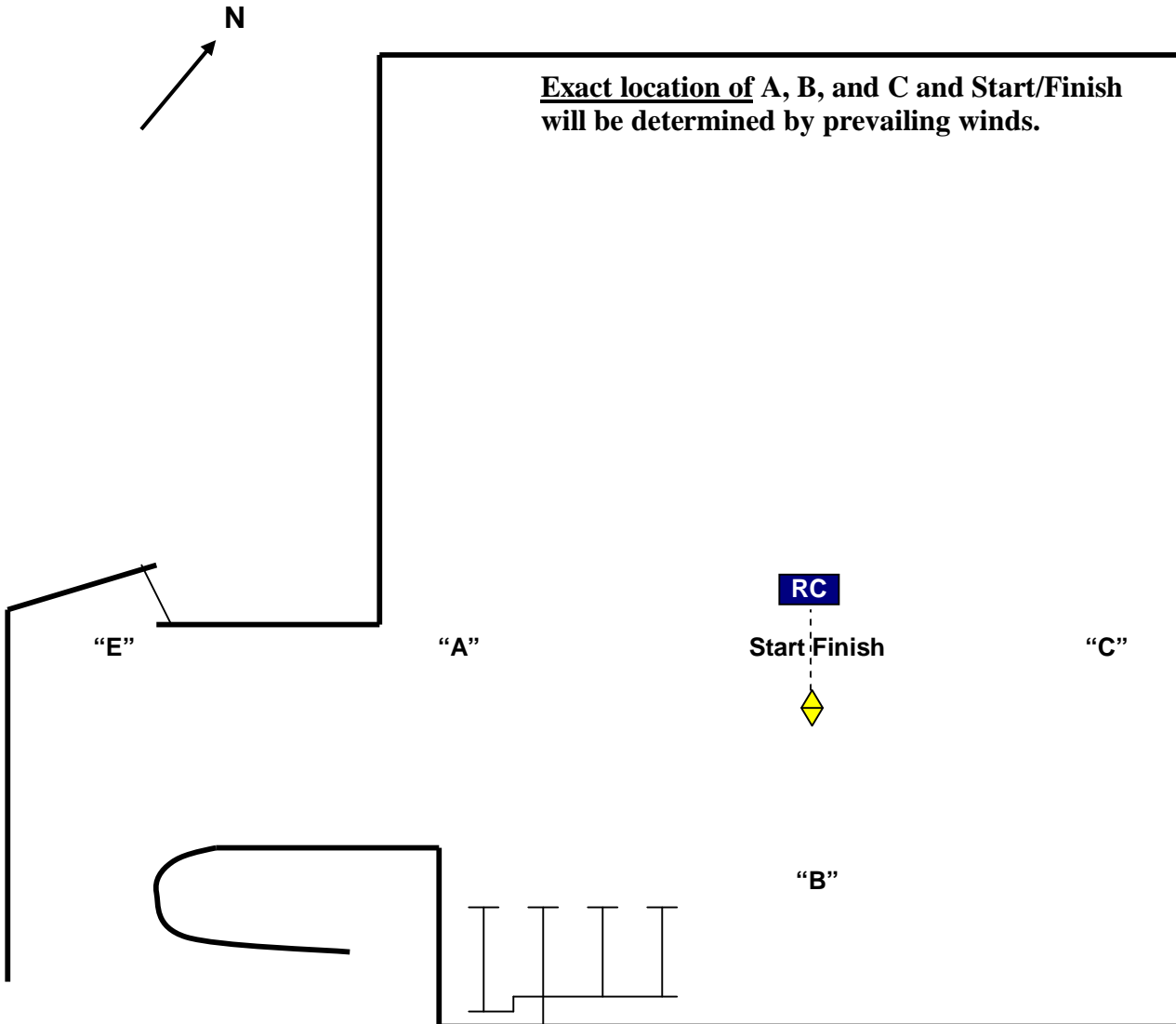
- 13.1 The low point scoring system, Appendix A of the RRS, as amended by these instructions will apply.
- 13.2 Five (5) races are scheduled; any races sailed will constitute the series.
- 13.3 Each boat's series total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. No races will be excluded. No Team scoring. Two boats per club allows for two chances to win for the club. If a club only floats one boat crew, it will not alter the regatta as each boat crew is scored individually.

14 Awards - Social Activities

- 14.1 The awards will be presented as soon as possible at the Post Race BBQ on the SMYC Patio, November 5th, 2011.

 To finish 1st lap, sail through the Start/finish line from the direction of the last mark and continue to sail the last lap.
